

Figure 1: Coughing number when swallowing 20ml samples for patients at different grades as assessed by the Water Drinking Test.

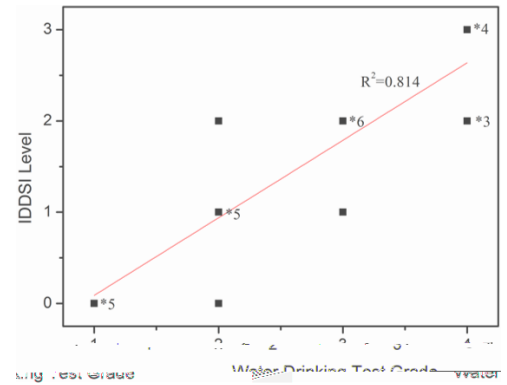


Figure 2: A positive correlation between IDDSI Level and Water Drinking Test Grade. The IDDSI Level is a measure of the consistency of a food or liquid, and the Water Drinking Test Grade is a measure of the patient's ability to swallow. The positive correlation indicates that as the patient's ability to swallow improves, the consistency of the food or liquid they can swallow also increases.
